



Why scan with scribzee?

By having everything within reach, on your phone, you can revise wherever and whenever you want. You no longer have to bring your notebooks, binders or sorting files with you.

What's the difference with a picture taken with your phone?

Scribzee reframes, straightens and enhances your scanned documents.

As a result, your notes are very easy to read. Not like some of your pictures where bits of pages are missing.

- Moreover, with scribzee, your scan isn't mixed up with the other photos in your gallery.
- And with scribzee, you have access to many features to track your revision.







Why use scribzee progress statuses?

- > To never have to ask yourself the question "where was I?" when learning your revision notes,
- Quickly visualise which lessons you need to revise first thanks to colour coding
- > Seeing your progress over time: there's nothing more satisfying!

4. Learn efficiently with flashcards

What are flashcards?

Small cards where you write a question on the front and the answer on the back. This simple method is terribly efficient to memorise vocabulary, formulas, definitions, dates and notions.



5 tips to create efficient flashcards

> Note one and only one information by flashcard

E1.

- Note the question or a word on the front and the answer or translation on the back
- Illustrate with diagrams and add colour to your flashcard
- Read the question on the front of the flashcard & try to find the answer without having a look at the back
- > Use the study & quiz modes in scribzee regularly

Memorise easily thanks to tailormade revisions based on the Leitner method

How it works?

The Leitner method is based on the principle of spaced repetition to facilitate rote learning. At the beginning, all the flashcards are in box n°1. When you answer a flashcard correctly, it's moved to box n°2 and so on, until in box 5 where the flashcard is considered mastered.

A powerful algorithm based on this model has been integrated into scribzee.

It creates personalised review sessions based on your knowledge of the flashcards. As a result, you spend time on the flashcards you know the least.

How it works?

In the same session, all the flashcards are shown & your score appears at the end. Then, you can choose to :

- Improve your result by reviewing only the flashcards you don't know again.
- Restart the whole quiz.




